

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF MUSEO DABAWENYO'S ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

January 2016

### **Exhibitions**

The University of Mindanao College of Architecture & Fine Arts Education students opened their exhibition with the title: "Art Atelier" at the Bahaghari Space of the museum on January 16, 2016, showcasing various works of art from paintings to sculptures. The exhibition ended on January 29, 2016.

On January 26, 2016, the Heavenly Culture, World Peace, Restoration of Light (HWPL), a non-governmental and non-profit organization for the cessation of war and advocating world peace, opened their exhibition with the title: "HWPL Peace Exhibition" at the Peace Hall of the museum. The exhibition will run until February 26, 2016.

### **Museum Guests**

A total of 3,579 guests came to the museum in January to learn more about our rich historical and cultural heritage.

1,811 or 51% were school-based (institutions) visitors 1,659 or 46% were walk-in guests, and 109 or 3% were lakbay-aral delegates.

Of the 1,811 school-based guests, 1,472 or 81% were from Davao City, while 19% or 339 students came from Regions III, VII, X, and XII.


Breaking down the 1,659 walk-in visitors into three categories, the domestic visitors top the list at 765 or 46%, the local visitors at 754 or 45%, and the foreign visitors at 140 or 8%.
