

HIGHLIGHTS OF MUSEO DABAWENYO'S ACCOMPLISHMENTS

February 2017

Exhibition

On February 21, 2017, the visual arts exhibition of multi-faceted and multi-awarded artist Ms. Elenita "Boots" Dumlao with the title: "Complexed Simplicities" opened at the Bahaghari Space of Museo Dabawenyo. The exhibition, featuring new and recent works of Ms. Dumlao, will run until March 23, 2017.

Promotional Activities

The Byaheng Do30 TV show of the City Information Office under the Government of Davao featured the museum on February 5, 2017 aired at GMA 5 Davao and interviewed Mr. Orly L. Escarrilla OIC Museo Dabawenyo and Ms. Librada P. Rufo, member of Davao Historical Society Foundation regarding the history of Japanese occupation in Davao.

Eyewitness of GMA TV station Manila hosted by Mr. Howie Severino visited and interviewed Ms. Maria Silayan Villavicencio, Center Educator in Museo Dabawenyo on February 18, 2017 as part of his documentary presentation entitled "Edsa in Davao" in relation to the celebration of Edsa Anniversary 2017 and it was aired on TV on February 25, 2017.

Cultural/Historical Undertakings

On February 3, 2017, Museo Dabawenyo provided venue for the National Commission for Indigenous Peoples - XI (NCIP-XI) in the conduct of their "Katutubo at Ako ay Iisa" poster making contest at the Peace Hall and was participated by five (5) IP youths from various places in Region XI.

The Brothers of the Sacred Heart Youth Ministry conducted spiritual and value formation activities for six (6) members of the Indigenous People at the Bantawan Area of the museum on February 5, 2017 and nine (9) members on February 19, 2017.

Museum Flyers

150 copies of Museo Dabawenyo flyers were handed out to selected museum guests.

Website

The official website of Museo Dabawenyo, the museo.davaocity.gov.ph under the web portal of the City Government of Davao has been updated regularly, to include announcements of current and upcoming exhibitions.

Museum Visitors

A total of 5,216 visitors came to the museum in February to learn more about our rich historical and cultural heritage.

3,454 or 66% were walk-in visitors, 1,687 or 32% were school-based (institutions) visitors, and 75 or 2% were lakbay-aral visitors.

Of the 1,687 school-based visitors, 647 or 38% were from Davao City, while 1,040 or 62% came from Regions XI (except Davao City), XII, ARMM and NCR.

Breaking down the 3,454 walk-in visitors into three categories, the domestic visitors top the list at 1,755 or 51%, the local visitors at 1,465 or 42%, and the foreign visitors at 234 or 7%.
