

HIGHLIGHTS OF MUSEO DABAWENYO'S ACCOMPLISHMENTS

August 2016

Exhibitions

Museo Dabawenyo hosted the exhibition with the title: "Piguras", an art exhibition of Davao contemporary figurative artists of the Piguras Art Group headed by its chairperson Mr. Byran H. Cabrera at the Bahaghari Space of the museum which formally opened on August 11, 2016. The exhibition will run until September 7, 2016.

The Davao Future Holdings organized an exhibition with the title: "Live Painting Exhibit by Ayumi Endo" at the Peace Hall of the museum from August 21-22, 2016, featuring paintings depicting the recent victory of Pres. Rodrigo R. Duterte, as well as other paintings by renowned Japanese artist Ms. Ayumi Endo.

Promotional Activities

Mr. Richard D. Vilar, Technical Assistant, was interviewed by Ms. Ivy, a reporter from ABS-CBN TV 4 Davao on August 5, 2016 about the history of the Hiyas Ng Kadayawan as part of their Kadayawan sa Dabaw special.

ABS-CBN TV 4 Davao's Maayong Buntag Mindanao (MBM) did their live show in Museo Dabawenyo on August 15, 2016 as part of their Kadayawan sa Dabaw festival feature with guests Kadayawan Execom Co-Chair Mr. Arturo Boncato, Jr., Execom Member Councilor Al Ryan Alejandre, and City Mayor's Chief-of-Staff Atty. Raul Nadela, Jr. Also featured were cultural performances in the museum by the cultural group from the Rizal Memorial Colleges.

On August 16, 2016, Ms. Bonna Mae Pamplona of ABS-CBN TV 4 Davao conducted random interviews to guests in Museo Dabawenyo about their Kadayawan and Davao experiences.

Historical/Cultural Undertaking

In-House and Outreach Programs/Technical Assistance Activities

Ms. Winnie Rose B. Galay-Bulig, Museum Researcher II, talked about the topic "Museology" to the officers and members of the Committed Organization of Modern and Progressive AB-History and Social Studies Students of Holy Cross of Davao College (COMPASS) on August 6, 2016 at the Holy Cross of Davao College in Davao City, as part of their acquaintance activity, with eighty (80) participants.

On August 18, 2016, the Davao Historical Society Foundation, Inc. (DHSFI) in cooperation with the Department of Education Davao City Schools Division and Museo Dabawenyo conducted the History Quiz competition for Secondary Level students of both public and private institutions in Davao City at the City Library, 3rd floor, SP Building. A total of forty-one (41) students participated in the said undertaking.

On August 26-28, 2016, Museo Dabawenyo hosted the ***Nining Dapita: Storytelling Write-shop and Dialogue on Peace*** organized by the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) through the LGU Zamboanga in partnership with Cultural Organizations and Institutions in Mindanao, more particularly the Kaliwat Performing Artists Collective, Inc. at the Bantawan Area and the Nanay Soling Duterte Hall of the museum. This three-day activity was participated by thirty (30) students from different public and private schools in Davao City, and is aimed to strengthen a culture of peace in the island by providing a venue for cultural dialogue and exchanges among the diverse peoples in Mindanao.

Familiarization Tour

Ms. Winnie Rose B. Galay-Bulig, visited the Bagobo Tagabawa community in Brgy. Astorga, Sta. Cruz, Davao del Sur on August 23, 2016, as part of the activities of the 4th General Assembly of the Local Historical Committees Network (LHCN) of the National Historical Commission of the Philippines held in Davao City.

Museum Guests

A total of 6,823 guests came to the museum in August to learn more about our rich historical and cultural heritage.

5,358 or 78% were walk-in guests, 934 or 14% were school-based (institutions) visitors, and 531 or 8% were lakbay-aral delegates.

Of the 934 school-based visitors, 700 or 75% were from Davao City, while 25% or 234 students came from Regions XI (except Davao City), XIII, ARMM, and NCR.

Breaking down the 5,358 walk-in visitors into three categories, the domestic visitors top the list at 3,013 or 56%, the local visitors at 39% or 2,086 and the foreign visitors at 259 or 5%.
