

MUSEUM TOUR GUIDELINES

For Group Tours, *Museo Dabawenyo* requires that reservation be made a week in advance either in writing through mail or email or by telephone call.

Museo Dabawenyo may be constrained to cancel without prior notice any reservation when unforeseen problems occur such as but not limited to brownouts or rallies within the vicinity of the building.

The museum visit would take around 30-45 minutes.

Teachers and parents or tour guides accompanying their respective classes or groups are requested to maintain discipline and proper decorum among their students or group members.

RULES TO BE OBSERVED DURING THE MUSEUM TOUR

All visitors are required to register at the reception. For big groups, a representative should register the visitors indicating the name of institution, address, age, gender, indigenous peoples affiliation (if applicable) and the name of the institution's head. This may be prepared before coming to the museum and must be submitted to the guard-on-duty at the reception desk.

Big bags, packages or boxes should be left in the buses/vehicles or deposited at the check-in counter with the guard.

Silence must be observed in the galleries and along the corridors.

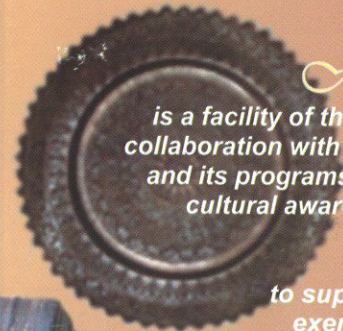
Smoking and eating are strictly prohibited inside the museum premises.

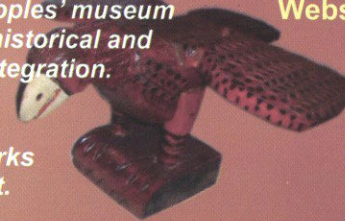

It is the intention of *Museo Dabawenyo* to support Davaenos whose works exemplify the Dabawenyo Spirit.



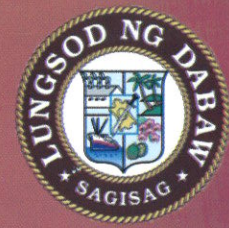

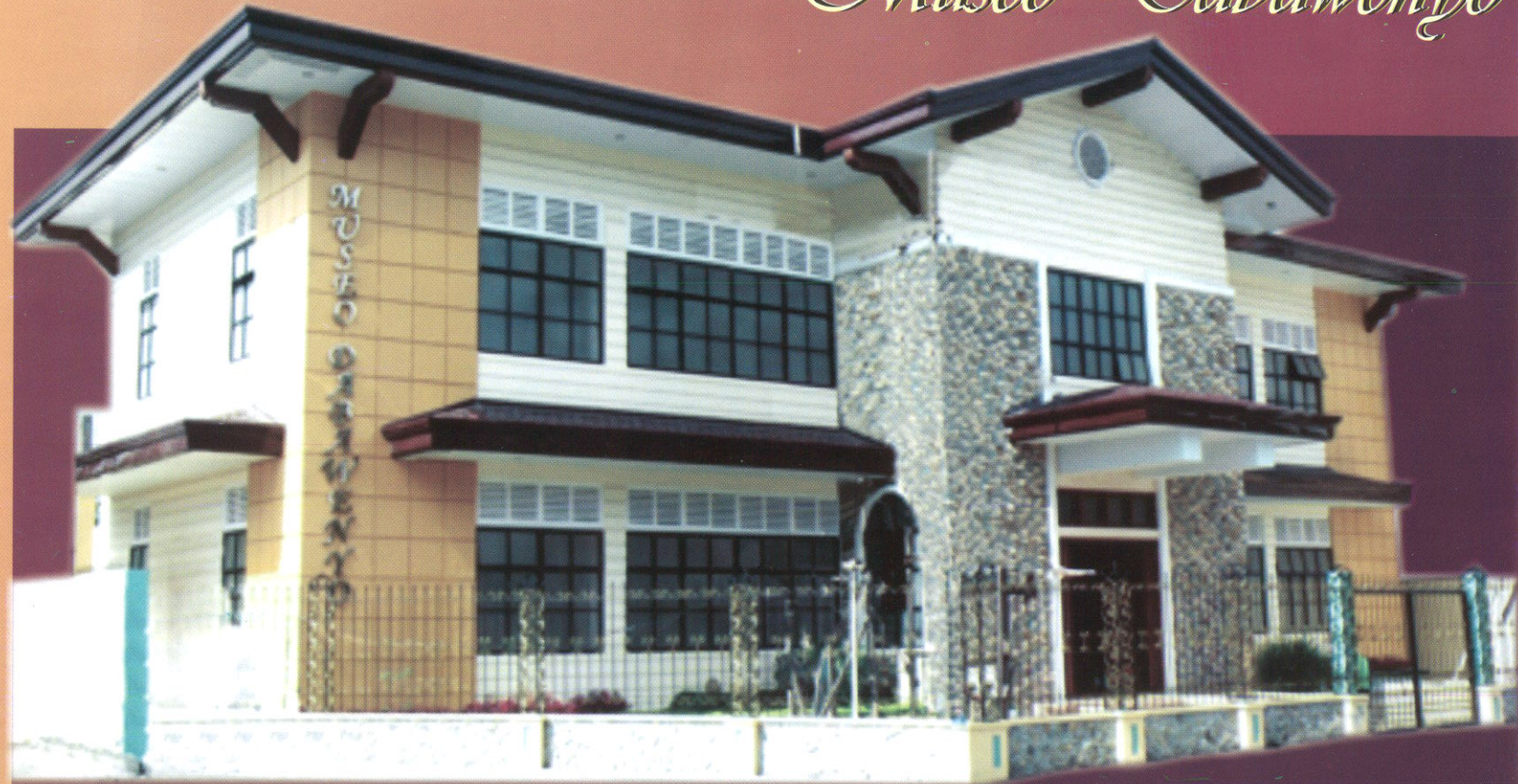
