

HIGHLIGHTS OF MUSEO DABAWENYO'S ACCOMPLISHMENTS

December 2017

Exhibition

Museo Dabawenyo hosted the visual arts exhibition with the title: "KABAYAN", Artists' Exchange – A Two Man Show featuring homegrown visual artist Mr. Victor "Bong" Espinosa and Manila artist and now USA-based Mr. Johnny Otilano from December 14, 2017 to January 11, 2018 at the Bahaghari Space of the museum.

Website

Museum Visitors

A total of 3,159 visitors came to the museum in December to learn more about our rich historical and cultural heritage.

2,681 or 85% were walk-in visitors, 322 or 10% were institutional visitors and 156 or 5% were lakbay-aral visitors.

Of the 322 school-based visitors, 163 or 51% came from ARMM, 97 or 30% came from Region XI (except Davao City), 34 or 10% came from Region VI, and 28 or 9% were from Region IX.

Breaking down the 2,681 walk-in visitors into three categories, the domestic visitors top the list at 1,576 or 59%, the local visitors at 951 or 35%, and the foreign visitors at 154 or 6%.
