Exhibition

From September 9 to October 13, 2017, Museo Dabawenyo hosted the "Pirma, the Lang Dulay Signatures exhibition", which highlighted the T'nalak fabrics woven by the late Lang Dulay of the T'boli Tribe from Lake Sebu and a Gawad sa Manlilikha ng Bayan Awardee (GAMABA).

Museum Visitors

A total of 5,091 visitors came to the museum in September to learn more about our rich historical and cultural heritage.

3,544 or 70% were walk-in visitors, 1,039 or 20% were Lakbay-aral visitors, and 508 or 10% were institutional visitors.

Of the 508 school-based visitors, 270 or 53% were from Davao City, while 238 or 47% came from Regions XI (except Davao City), and XIII.

Breaking down the 3,544 walk-in visitors into three categories, the domestic visitors top the list at 1,961 or 55%, the local visitors at 1,469 or 42%, and the foreign visitors at 114 or 3%.
