Exhibition

From October 17 to November 13, 2017, Museo Dabawenyo hosted the exhibition with the title: "Atelier 2017", an annual art exhibition of the students under the Fine Arts Program of the University of Mindanao featuring paintings and sculptures.

Research Activity

In compliance to Memorandum Circular No. 25 issued by Malacañang, more particularly on the display of the identified Philippine Heroes in various government offices all over the country, the Museo Dabawenyo conducted research on the lives of these eleven heroes, to include their photos, and the photos of which are now on display in one of the walls in the museum.

Museum Visitors

A total of 5,054 visitors came to the museum in October to learn more about our rich historical and cultural heritage.

3,575 or 71% were walk-in visitors, 1,264 or 25% were institutional visitors and 215 or 4% were lakbay-aral visitors.

Of the 1,264 school-based visitors, 64 or 5% were from Davao City, while 1,200 or 95% came from Region XI (except Davao City).

Breaking down the 3,575 walk-in visitors into three categories, the domestic visitors top the list at 2,109 or 59%, the local visitors at 1,372 or 38%, and the foreign visitors at 94 or 3%.
