

HIGHLIGHTS OF MUSEO DABAWENYO'S ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Exhibitions

Museo Dabawenyo opened the exhibition of Engr. Manuel Mendros with the title: "Inner East Rhythms and Forms Series-Psychometry" at the Bahaghari Space of Museo Dabawenyo on January 17, 2018. The exhibition featured paintings based on his near-death experience which resulted into a series of kaleidoscopic images. The exhibition ended on February 13, 2018.

Selected Special Program for the Arts (SPA) students from the Davao City National High School (DCNHS) exhibited their photos taken during the Kadayawan sa Davao 2017 with the title: "Dagway Dabawenyo" at the Peace Hall of the museum from January 29 to February 28, 2018.

Museum Visitors

A total of 3,433 visitors came to the museum in January to learn more about our rich historical and cultural heritage.

2,827 or 82% were walk-in visitors, 504 or 15% were school-based (institutions) visitors, and 102 or 3% were lakbay-aral visitors.

All of the 504 school-based visitors were from Davao City.

Breaking down the 2,827 walk-in visitors into three categories, the domestic visitors top the list at 1,331 or 47%, the local visitors at 1,229 or 44%, and the foreign visitors at 267 or 9%.
