

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF MUSEO DABAWENYO'S ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

### **Exhibition**

On February 19, 2018, the visual arts exhibition of multi-faceted and multi-awarded artist Ms. Elenita "Boots" Dumlao with the title: "Colors & Textures" opened at the Bahaghari Space of Museo Dabawenyo. The exhibition featured new and recent works of Ms. Dumlao with her life-experiences as her inspiration. The exhibition ended on March 17, 2018.

### **Museum Visitors**

A total of 4,205 visitors came to the museum in February to learn more about our rich historical and cultural heritage.

3,134 or 75% were walk-in visitors, 808 or 19% were school-based (institutions) visitors, and 263 or 6% were lakbay-aral visitors.

Of the 808 school-based visitors, 406 or 50% were from Davao City, while 402 or 50% came from Regions III, IV-A Calabarzon, XII and the ARMM.

Breaking down the 3,134 walk-in visitors into three categories, the domestic visitors top the list at 1,667 or 53%, the local visitors at 1,290 or 41%, and the foreign visitors at 177 or 6 %.
